DCOs for New Roads

- Limited categories e.g. construction of SOS roads in England over relevant site area threshold
- Possibility of SOS Direction that other projects are NSIP, must be considered nationally significant
- Examples of s35 Directions so far:-
 - Norwich Northern Distributor Road
 - Silvertown Tunnel
- DCO combines planning, CPO and highways powers (e.g. stopping up, TROs)
